- Day 6** Over the Lesja Road to Skjak for the Borva, Ostri & Otta, along with the Euro Wave
- Day 7-8** Head back to Otta for departure to Voss, a day of down time and enjoying thr route West
- Day 9** Step back into Steepness with the Classic section on the Raundal
- Day 10** More of the same, steep, fast and fun
- Day 11** Much more of the same, steep, fast and fun
- Day 12** Lake to Lake Park'n'Huck, and then the Money Drop after lunch
- Day 13** A Westcoast Classic, the Lower Myrkedal, over 20 drops higher than than 4m
- Day 14** Upper Raundal section to finish at the famed Nosebreaker Waterfall
- Day 15** Pack up your memories and head on home by train or bus to Oslo from Voss or on the plane from Bergen
